

THE EFFECT OF LISTENING SONGS TO ENRICH VOCABULARY AT TENTH GRADE SMAN 7 KEDIRI

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ABSTRACT

The background of this research is based on the researcher's observations and experience. This study about to enrich students vocabularies. Sometimes students have difficulty mastering some vocabulary in English, such as: synonyms and antonyms because of the lack of mastery of the students' vocabulary so it is difficult to get the right answer. In teaching vocabulary, the teacher has to use better methods such as listening to English song technique to make students interested in learning vocabulary because songs are one of the most interested and rich resources of vocabulary that can easily be used in language classrooms to make the stdents get more ideas from the songs they hear. The sample of this research is the X MIPA 5 of SMAN 7 KEDIRI consist of 15 students. The instrument that are used are test. The test is given to know the students' mastering vocabulary before being taught by listening to English song which are in the form of pretest and after being taught by listening to teaching learning to English song has significant effect on the student.


METHOD





From the diagram Pre-test and Post-Test above, it can be seen that after being taugh by listening son, the students' score are increasing. It can be concluded that the diagram score above showing the post-test score is better that pretest score. From the explanation, it can be formed into a diagram below:



From the diagram above, it can be sen that each students had better score in post-test than pre-test. The higher score in pre-test was 80, while the lowest score in pre-test was 45. In post-test, the score was increased. The higher score was 90, while the lower score was 64. The data shows that t-score is higher than t-table in significant 1%. Therefore, the alternative hypothesis (Ha) is accepted and null hypothesis (Ho) is rejected.

CONCLUTION
