Ultimately, this analysis not only sheds light on Sia's artistic expression but also emphasizes the importance of delving beyond surface meanings in song lyrics to uncover richer emotional narratives. A song is a method for communication and understanding the goal of meaning in it. 1.1 Lexical Meaning

The lowest unit of meaning in a linguistic system is called lexical meaning. Meaning in lexical terms is held without alteration by the lexeme in any given situation. That interpretation is what's real. something can be seen by using human reason. One common definition of lexical meaning is "the study of terms' meanings (Murphy, 2010). In different According to Kreidler (1998), the significance comprises meaning in terms of words and grammar, reference, and meaning relationships, connotation, and denotation. Morphemes, polysemy, lexical homophones, and sentences, meaning, and ambiguity. The lexeme "dog," for instance, has a lexical meaning. that is a little, four-legged, hairy animal, and a back. Additionally, the lexeme "bridge" has a meaning. It is a structure designed to allow people to confront. 1.2 Contextual Meaning

According to Chaer (2007) cited in Septiana (2017), contextual Meaning is the connotation of a word or set of words. Moreover, contextual definition is a definition in the context in a more expansive manner with a wider justification. Here, the background information helps to encourage the clarity of meaning. Similarly According to Palmer (1976), a term can have distinct connotation depending on the distribution. For instance, in the word "head," though The meaning can be clarified by the context as "Grandma has a lot of white hair on her head." and "The Students who excel are given prizes by the headmaster. In the first sentence, the word "head" refers to the the hairy top portion of the body. However, the second sentence's use of the word "head" refers to a school's principal. One can categorize contextual meaning into interpretations of the temporal situation that clarify meaning according to location, time, and circumstance the background against which the message is explained where something occurs physically, and words context that clarifies the language's usage. Contextual meaning can be divided into meanings of the context of time which explains meaning based on time context, based on place context which explain the meaning is based where the palce something happen, and language context which explain the language use. Besides that the context of the situation also greatly influences the meaning, like scared situation or enjoy situation and other. 2.0 Research Methods
